About McClatchy's PTSA

Our budget is small. We conduct only one membership and fundraising drive in the fall for the entire year—NO gift wrap or cookie dough for us! Our main goal is to provide a forum for the exchange of ideas and information with parents, students, staff and the community throughout the year.

The PTSA meets five times per year and invites speakers and CKM staff to discuss various topics of interest, such as student health and safety, school programs, and class scheduling at CKM. Our meetings will be held from **6:30pm-8:00pm at the CKM Media Center** usually on the fourth Monday of the month. The first one will be September 28.

We encourage you to join us at these meetings. It's a great way to meet new parents, be involved in your student's school, and learn what's happening on campus.

In addition to joining PTSA, we encourage you to consider giving an additional donation to the PTSA. The money we raise helps to fund teacher grants, staff appreciation events and other programs that benefit all students.

Where the Money Goes

Teacher Grants

Last year, the PTSA gave out over \$4,000 in teacher grants to complement academic offerings and enrich the art programs. Funded projects included new microscopes; new sheet music for our performing arts programs; ceramics supplies; and a new camera for the photography program, to name a few.

Website Support

The PTSA supplements the school's website--an important communication tool for parents, students, and our community. Students and parents can find important, current information on school events and deadlines, as well as general information, such as the school directory, campus map and course catalog.
