The Making of a Student Schedule

Course selection at CKM is a carefully arranged series of steps progressing from February through August each year, which includes:

1. One on one course selection with counselors and students based on transcript analysis.
2. Review of selections and recommendations by counselors and Assistant Principal.
3. Reassessment based on year-end grades and final course offerings.
4. Adjustments as needed to reflect any summer school courses.
5. Final programming by computer-scheduling procedures.

Course changes made after the school year begins interfere with the educational progress of all students, staffing and class loads. We are reluctant to upset schedules unless the reasoning is beyond our control (i.e. course leveling). We urged students to choose their courses wisely. Therefore, we must strictly adhere to the established class change policy for scheduled changes in the fall.

Class changes will only be made if:

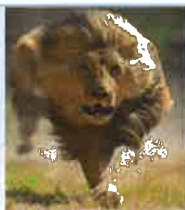
1. A student is currently registered for or has completed the scheduled course through summer school, etc. (documentation required with this request).
2. A failing grade or- No Credit was received the previous semester what was a pre-requisite for the current course.
