Where the Money Goes

Teacher Grants

In 2017-2018, the PTSA awarded nearly \$3,000 in teacher grants to complement academic offerings and enrich the art programs. In the past, funded projects included new microscopes; new sheet music for our performing arts programs; a new Olympic weight bench, a new camera for the photography program, and educational supplies for the Student Support Center.
