Has your child's bus route changed?

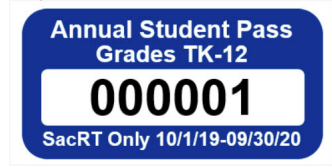

TAKE ADVANTAGE OF THE STUDENT **FARE-FREE** TRANSIT PASS PROGRAM!



SacRT has partnered with the City of Sacramento to offer free fare for students in grades K through 12 to ride SacRT buses and light rail vehicles. Students who either go to school within the City limits of Sacramento or reside within the City limits, but attend a school outside the City's boundaries are eligible.

From October 1, 2019 through September 30, 2020, the SacYOUthGO program will provide an estimated 250,000 students the opportunity to ride any of SacRT's fixed-route or Smart Ride microtransit services at any time free of charge!

The student fare-free passes will be made available in the form of a sticker to be placed directly on the student's school identification (ID) card, allowing schools to print and issue ID cards with the transit pass sticker already affixed to them.
